LIVE SYSTEM START - OBEY ALL SIGNS

Fremantle Ports has established a Congestion Management System to assist you in congestion situations. The system has a series of electronic signs on Port precinct roads to give you diversion instructions & a TMA Driver Entry Screen to allow you to confirm who you are & register your destination intentions.

IMPORTANT! From now on, please obey all sign messages;

If the signs mention a site you are going to next, please follow the instructions (especially "Go to TMA");

- Drive into the TMA slowly;
- Park in a Grid;
- Go to the Driver Entry Hut to Register;
- At the Hut Entry Screen, (i) choose the picture of your truck, (ii) confirm your licence plate & (iii) tell us where you are going;
- Watch the Large VMS screens for your call up (don't worry if you miss your first call, the call up remains on the screen for 30 minutes) - you'll be called up "first come first served";
- Once called, go to the site as soon as you can.

If you see a sign telling you "Site Congestion" for your next destination and to "Go to TMA" make your way to the entrance to the TMA off North Mole Drive (just above the Lunch shop entrance), drive in, park in the grid and register at the hut.

DO NOT GO TO SITE (UNLESS INSTRUCTED).

ASSISTANCE - WHEN THE SYSTEM IS OPERATING

Initially, Fremantle Ports' staff will be at the TMA to help.
