A permanent directional waverider buoy has been positioned approximately 150 metres to the south west of Deep Water Channel No 1 buoy.

*Light Characteristics*  
Fl.Y.(5)20s

The waverider buoy has been positioned such that it should not impede incoming or outgoing commercial vessels using either the Deep Water Channel or Western Approaches.
