Semi-Sub Rig OCEAN APEX Departure

The semi-submersible rig OCEAN APEX is currently on a 8-point anchor pattern at Outer Anchorage O7 / coordinates 31° 56.44' South; 115° 39.79' East.

In preparation for departure, OCEAN APEX will be undertaking anchor recovery operation with the assistance of Far Senator and Bhagwan Renegade. The anchor recovery operations will be from 16th April 2021 at approximately 0600 hours to 19th April 2021 Noon.

All vessels are to provide a wide berth with no less than 2000m clearance. This is in exception for commercial vessels under the direction of Fremantle Ports VTS passing the Fairway buoy and utilising the Approach Channel.

All recreational & commercial vessels are to navigate with caution. This includes taking direction from Fremantle Ports VTS and in the immediate interest of safety VHF directions OCEAN APEX, Far Senator or Bhagwan Renegade as well.
