To pre-register for the competition, print out and complete the form on the next page and email the form and a high resolution photograph of your work to [paint@fremantleports.com.au](mailto:paint@fremantleports.com.au). Submissions for pre-registration close **Monday 9 March, 5PM**. Shortlisted entrants will be contacted by **Wednesday 11 March** and will be required to deliver their photograph or artwork originals in either A4 or A3 format, unframed and unmounted by Thursday 12 March to Fremantle Ports Administration Building, 1 Cliff Street, Fremantle before 4PM. Entry is free.

Shortlisted entries will be displayed in a pop up exhibition at the "Paint the Port" Community Day on Saturday 14 March.

'On the day' submissions must be created on Saturday 14 March and submitted by 11am, the same day at B Shed, Victoria Quay. Standard A4 and A3 submission format applies. Digital photographic submissions can also be made via Instagram with the hashtag #Painttheport2020

# Entry Conditions

Please read all the information below carefully and make sure you sign and include the declaration and attach it to your submission. Submissions that do not include a signed copy of this declaration will **not** be considered.

## Conditions of Entry

- Pre-registration entries must be submitted online using a high resolution photograph of your artwork via email to [paint@fremantleports.com.au](mailto:paint@fremantleports.com.au). Entry is free.
- This form **must** be submitted with all entries.
- Online entries must be received by close of business on Monday 9 March 2020. Shortlisted submissions will be notified by Wednesday 10 March.
- Each entrant is permitted to enter one artwork or photograph in each relevant category.
- The photographs and artworks must have a theme related to 'Fremantle Port in all its phases' i.e. images of container ships, pilot boats, port infrastructure, people, marine life, wharves, moles, lighthouses, cranes, etc.
- When submitted via email, each artwork or photograph must be accompanied by a completed application, title and no more than 25 words describing the work and the moment in which it was taken. This text must be written by the artist or photographer.
- All works must be the original, unaided work of the entrant and completed within six months of the entry date.
- A panel of judges selected by Fremantle Ports will choose the winners. All shortlisted entrants will be contacted on Wednesday, 11 March and must deliver their original works to Fremantle Ports Administration Building on Victoria Quay, on Thursday 12 March before 4 pm in an A3 or A4 format only, unframed and unmounted. All artworks and photographs will be attached to the exhibition board by Velcro adhesive. The competition is open to anyone subject to category selection.
- Entries in the 'On the day' category must be completed on Saturday 14 March on Victoria Quay only and submitted between 9am and 11am on Saturday 14. Artists must complete a registration form when submitting their work. Registration form and check in will be available on the day at Fremantle Ports B Shed venue on Victoria Quay. 'On the day' finalists will be notified by mobile telephone on the day.
- There will be a total of eight prizes: Open, on the day submissions, 6 to 12 years and 13 to 18 years (four photography and four artwork).
- All shortlisted entries will be displayed at a pop up exhibition on the Paint the Port Community Day.
- Fremantle Ports reserves the right to use the artworks for promotional purposes including but not limited to advertising, publicity, commercial or other business purposes at no cost to Fremantle Ports for 12 months from the submission date. Copyright remains with the artist.
- Shortlisted applicants must be able to attend the Paint the Port event on Saturday 14 March for the announcement of the winners at 4pm in B Shed on Victoria Quay.
- Fremantle Ports takes no responsibility or liability for any damage or loss of artworks or photographs displayed.
- Shortlisted works which are displayed at the pop up exhibition will need to be removed from the B Shed between 4pm and 4.15pm on Saturday 14 March.
- Judges are looking for interesting, innovative and unusual photographs and artworks
- Judges decisions are final and not negotiable
