Request must be sent to the Harbour Master's Office (through the vessel agents) not less than 24hrs prior to planned works, except in case of emergencies Email: <u>harbourmaster@fremantleports.com.au</u>

Notes:

- 1. Hot work approval will be granted only when an operational need is considered as necessary while the vessel is in the Port of Fremantle
- 2. Hot work requests will not be approved under the below mentioned conditions:
 - during periods of 'Total Fire Bans' as issued from time-to-time by the WA Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES), except in case of emergencies
 - when a vessel is carrying dangerous goods on board
 - at Kwinana Bulk Jetty (KBJ), when a vessel carrying Ammonium Nitrate is at berth no hot work will be approved for the vessel or any other vessel at KBJ
 - at Kwinana Bulk Terminal (KBT) when an LPG tanker is alongside
- The vessel's hot work permit is to be sent to the Harbour Masters Office prior to commencement of work by email.
 Fremantle VTS must be notified on VHF channel 12 when hot work has commenced.
 A notification is to be sent to <u>harbourmaster@fremantleports.com.au</u> and <u>movements@fremantleports.com.au</u> on completion
- 4. Hot work approval will be issued for a maximum period of 24hrs per approval
- 5. Hot work at Kwinana Grain Jetty, BP Refinery & Alcoa will be permitted only after prior consultation with the terminals
