Deployment of subsurface instruments - Cockburn Sound Vicinity

Mariners are advised that five subsurface sound recorders are scheduled to be deployed around Thursday 21 July 2022 in Cockburn Sound vicinity at the following locations (indicative only):

Location 1: 32° 08.4' S, 115° 43.6'

Location 2: 32° 08.6' S, 115° 43.0'

Location 3: 32° 08.6' S, 115° 42.7'

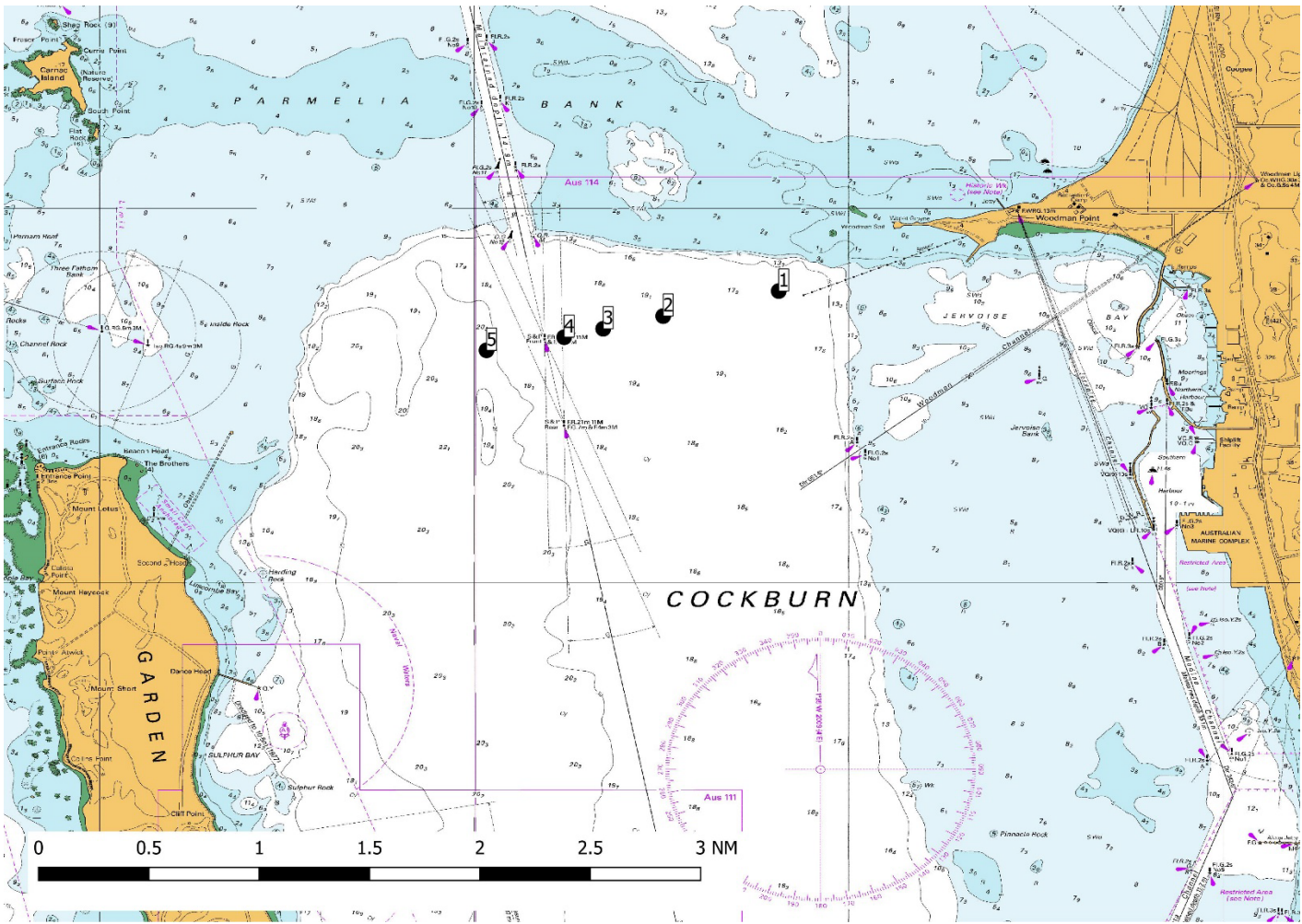
Location 4: 32° 08.7' S, 115° 42.5'

Location 5: 32° 08.8' S, 115° 42.1'

The sound recorders will be tied to a ground line (around 65 metres long) with a dump weight of around 36 kilograms attached to it and with a clearance of approximately 17 meters to the surface of the water at LAT (Lowest Astronomical Tide).

The above recorders will be deployed as part of the WAMSI Westport Research Projects and will be recovered around 15.08.2022.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the above area.
