10(T)/2011**

**FREMANTLE PORT  
WHALE SEASON**

*Date* – On or after September, 2011

*Former Notice* – FPA NTM 9(T)/2011 is cancelled

Migrating and resting whales are expected to be in the vicinity of Fremantle Ports port waters from September through November inclusive with peak activity in mid-October.

Within this period, it is expected that whale sightings may be common and Mariner's are advised to navigate with due care and appropriate caution around any whale activity including reducing to an appropriate speed suitable to maintain safe navigation.

Commercial Mariners are encouraged to report any sightings of whales to the VTS via an approximate bearing and distance reference to a fixed object (ie navigational buoy or beacon).

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution.
