Subject: Post adverse weather berth scheduling after 2 August 2023

All Shipping Agents operating in the Port of Fremantle are to note the following

The in-force weather forecast (gale warning) for Perth Local Waters, Perth Coast and Lancelin Coast - Areas being monitored for Fremantle Ports, is valid until 2 August 2023 - 2400 hours LT (midnight). A strong wind warning continues to be applicable for Perth Local Waters for until 3 August 2023 - 2400 hours LT (midnight).

Vessels will be scheduled for berthing from 3 August 2023 - 0800 hours onwards based on existing wind, sea and swell conditions in compliance with Fremantle Ports' operational parameters at the time of commencement of vessel movements.

The following indicative approach will be implemented when scheduling vessels to berth

- Vessels will be scheduled to berth in the Outer Harbour and Inner Harbour based on availability of resources for each manoeuvre, beginning with the Outer Harbour berths. So as far as practicable, priority will be given to vessels returning to a berth.
- Vessels that are not bound for a berth will be scheduled to anchor at ORA /ORAN anchorages in-between time-gaps on 3 August. These vessels will however, not be prioritised for 3 August.
- Applicable vessels will be permitted to proceed to anchor - Gage Roads and Outer anchorages after 3 August 1200 hours LT.
