
Dangerous cargo that is identified as being high hazard, can not be moved through our port area without permission first being granted by the Dangerous Cargo Officer. Permission is sought by the agent filling in a **Request for Permission** form which is available in Voyager Dangerous Cargo on the Internet.

The purpose of this presentation is to show you how to fill in then submit this electronic form.


## High hazard dangerous cargoes for which permission is required. . .

CLASS	DESCRIPTION	NOTES
Class 1	<b>Explosives</b>	Applies to all explosives (except for Division 1.4)
Class 2.1	<b>Flammable Gases</b>	Applies to quantities of packaged Class 2.3 load/unload exceeding 500 kg (excludes cylinders) and transit exceeding 25000 kg (excludes cylinders, drums)  Applies to bulk (excludes transit cargoes of Class 2.2)
Class 2.2	<b>Compressed Gases</b>	
Class 2.3	<b>Toxic Gases</b>	
Class 3	<b>Flammable Liquids</b>	Applies to Packing Group I in bulk only
Class 4	<b>Flammable Solids</b>	Only when transported in bulk
Class 5	<b>Oxidising Substances</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◆ Packing Group I in quantities exceeding 400 tonnes; or</li><li>◆ Ammonium nitrate or calcium hypochlorite in quantities exceeding 30 tonnes (packaged in containers) at North Quay common user berths or 150 tonnes (break bulk – e.g. loose IBCs) at Kwinana Bulk Jetty</li><li>◆ Ammonium nitrate or ammonium nitrate fertilizers in bulk</li><li>◆ All classes 5.1 and 5.2 (only when transported in bulk).</li></ul>
Class 6.1	<b>Toxic Substances</b>	Only when transported in bulk
Class 7	<b>Radioactive Material</b>	Applies to all radioactive substances (excludes transit cargoes)
Class 8	<b>Corrosive Substances</b>	Applies to Packing Group I in bulk only

Here is a list of dangerous cargo that Fremantle Ports classifies as HIGH hazard.



This flow chart illustrates how the **Request for Permission** form relates to the other processes in Voyager Dangerous Cargo.



Remember that you **only** need to fill in a request for permission form if you have **high hazard dangerous cargo**.



#### Permission Conditions:

The transport and handling of dangerous goods must comply with Australian Standard AS3846-2005. A 24 hour specialist advice contact phone number must be made available for the dangerous cargo. AMSA Organisation must be immediately advised of your intention to import this substance. On completing of loading, the loaded ship or vehicle shall depart from the port area as soon as is reasonably practicable. The ship's engines and ancillary equipment shall be kept ready at all times, so that the ship can leave the berth at short notice. When more than 100kg of explosives (excluding 1.4) is loaded or unloaded in a port area, a shipper's or consignee's representative shall be present who, if any incident develops, has access to expert technical advice. The ship shall be berthed in a direction that will allow the quickest departure from the berth in an emergency. The dangerous goods shall be delivered to the berth within 12h of being loaded on a vessel and they shall be removed from the berth within 12h of being unloaded from a vessel. Road vehicles carrying explosives (excluding 1.4S) shall be at least 100m apart while waiting to load a ship. Repairs involving hot work is prohibited on the ship or on the berth whilst explosives (excluding 1.4S) are being transported or handled. Explosives (except Division 1.4) shall not be brought to a berth for loading onto a ship unless the ship is ready to receive them. The handling of explosives, once commenced, shall proceed without delay or interruption, except during electrical storms.

The transport and handling of dangerous goods must comply with Australian Standard AS3846-2005. A 24 hour specialist advice contact phone number must be made available for the dangerous cargo. AMSA Organisation must be immediately advised of your intention to import this substance. On completing of loading, the loaded ship or vehicle shall depart from the port area as soon as is reasonably practicable. The ship's engines and ancillary equipment shall be kept ready at all times, so that the ship can leave the berth at short notice. When more than 100kg of explosives (excluding 1.4) is loaded or unloaded in a port area, a shipper's or consignee's representative shall be present who, if any incident develops, has access to expert technical advice. The ship shall be berthed in a direction that will allow the quickest departure from the berth in an emergency. The dangerous goods shall be delivered to the berth within 12h of being loaded on a vessel and they shall be removed from the berth within 12h of being unloaded from a vessel. Road vehicles carrying explosives (excluding 1.4S) shall be at least 100m apart while waiting to load a ship. Repairs involving hot work is prohibited on the ship or on the berth whilst explosives (excluding 1.4S) are being transported or handled. Explosives (except Division 1.4) shall not be brought to a berth for loading onto a ship unless the ship is ready to receive them. The handling of explosives, once commenced, shall proceed without delay or interruption, except during electrical storms.


