**SUBJECT: Fremantle Ports - New 'Vessel Request for Hot Work' form**

---

**Compliance with this requirement is mandatory for all vessels calling at the Port of Fremantle.**

In accordance Fremantle Ports' continual improvement process, a new form for vessels requesting for Hot Work is being introduced. This form applies to all vessels requesting for Hot Work while within limits of the Port of Fremantle waters - Anchorages and berths. If a main engine immobilisation is required along with the Hot Work, the existing 'Request to immobilise main engine' form continues to apply, in addition to the Hot work request.

The form provides for an enhanced risk management and decision-making process for Fremantle Ports. Instructions regarding the use of the form are mentioned in the form and applicable requirements are mentioned in the 'notes' section of the form.

The new form is attached along with this Harbour Master's Instruction for reference.
